Arts and Science Schedule

May 28– We are making scroll covers. Please bring foam core or large pieces of cardboard, light weight fabric, ribbon for ties and a little hot glue (not sure that this will be used.)

June 4– Embroidery lecture for the 15th through the 16th century. To include but not limited to coifs, Jackets, caskets, a sewing pillow, etc..

June 11– Intarsia or Inlaid patchwork lecture and small project. This is a tapestry stitching technique for doing pictorial work. Please bring small wick sharp scissors and any felted wool scraps you might have. Do not purchase materials.

June 18– Inkle weaving. Bring a warped inkle loom and your pattern. If you do not know how to weave, we will have looms available for learning.

June 25– Tristan and Iseult quilt lecture followed by a little hands on class. The Tristan and Iseult quilt is a trapunto or stuffed stitching quilt.

July 2– Scroll blanks. Hands on drawing class for scroll blanks from 1400's. Bring what you have, do not purchase supplies until you understand what you need.

July 9– We will work on making hoods for the loaner gear and learn how to put a fancy edge on the hoods.

July 16– Eura dress lecture. A different style of t-tunic.

July 23– Cotehardie class. Patterns will be available for copying, bring something to copy them onto large paper or scrap fabric. A few dresses may be available to try on.

17 May 2015

Baronage: Thank you to all who helped make favours on Thursday.

Seneschal: Eleanor got her warrant as chatelaine.

Exchequer: quarterly report was submitted and we have funds.

Marshal:

John Biggeheved Has been warranted and assumed his duties

Archery: New person at archery but she will be moving out of the barony. No archery next week due to Ruby Joust, after that we will resume as usual.

MOL: Not present, check your cards.

A&S: Absent- the new schedule will be in the Noddy. Christara is having health issues so won't be at A&S for awhile. Summer university is 13 Jun, Lady Mariss has 3 open seats in her coach for a day trip.

Chatelain: Absent due to car trouble Nothing new

Herald: Still looking for a deputy. Has one request for name and device pending.

Webminister: Still awaiting full turnover. Needs appropriate program.

Sir Tnek suggests we may be able to make our own hardware. Stakes needed unknown at this time. Stain and varnish will also be needed. We can probably SKIP POSTAGE IF WE PICK THINGS UP AT PENNSIC. WE WILL NEED A WORK DAY and Lad y Kaleeb will need 2 weeks notice to pre-order the poles etc.

Will need approximately \$1000. We will vote next meeting.

Father's Day Marinus generally hAas a big cook out at fighter practice. 21 Jun at Mt Trashmore.

Events for next year: Baronial Birthday. We plan to put in for KA&S, waiting for the site to request. The baron suggests we have spring crown 7 May as a back up to Kingdom A&S.
