Mistress Alyna has been a member of the SCA for 25 years. Starting out as a college student in the Midrealm she served as Herald and deputy Chatelaine. After finding her home in Atlantia she participated in the College of Rencester at the College of William and Mary before establishing herself in the Barony of Tir-y-don. Her SCA interests vary widely from dance and music, rapier fighting, archery, costuming, and a plethora of diverse arts. She also serves as a rapier marshal, minister of the list, and is currently Baronial Exchequer.

Master Jean Claude has been a member of the Kingdom of Atlantia for 29 years; starting in the Shire of Hindscroft (now Canton of Middlegate). He has also lived in the Barony of Hidden Mountain before settling in Tir-y-Don. His SCA interests include fencing, brewing, dance, and fighting spear. 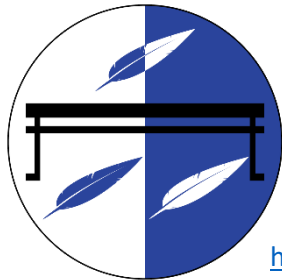

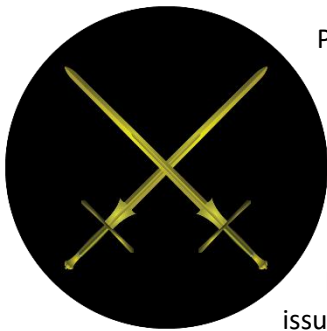
