## July Letter from the Baron and Broness of Tir-y-Don

We, Oriana and John, send our greetings on this warm June day. We have been very busy attending events; Ruby Joust, Highland River Melees and Summer University. We saw several of our wonderful members honored and are looking forward to more in the future. If you have any award recommendations, please let us know. This includes Kingdom level awards. If we agree with your recommendations for Kingdom awards, we will happily add our voices to yours!

We also want your ideas and feedback regarding new awards that we plan to create. We plan to create an Equestrian award to parallel the Kingdom Order of Merit, The Order of the Quintain. “The Order of the Quintain honors and recognizes those subjects who have distinguished themselves by their consistent effort and shown excellence in the pursuit of equestrian activities.” Similarly, we plan to create a single generic award comparable to the Kingdom Awards, The Award of the Shark’s Tooth, The Award of the Silver Nautilus, or The Award of the Fountain. “The Award of the Shark's Tooth recognizes and honors those who have performed acts of valor for the Kingdom of Atlantia. The Award of the Silver Nautilus honors and recognizes those who have distinguished themselves by an extraordinary achievement in the Arts and Sciences. The Award of the Fountain recognizes and honors those who have performed acts of service for the Kingdom of Atlantia.” This award would honor those who have performed acts of valor, distinguished themselves by an extraordinary creation in the Arts and Sciences, have performed special acts of service, or any other such actions as bring honor to the Barony of Tir-y-Don. Recipients of this award would be able to receive it more than once. The ideas we have received so far are:

- An annulo of Estoiles (Circle of stars with six wavy points). Proposed Blazon: Per pale vert and azure, an estoiles in annulo or (shield divided vertically with one side green and one side blue, with a circle of stars with six wavy points, in gold). This references the Sea Star or Star Fish. It also brings the gold star symbolism into play.
- An Octopus. This references the many hands make light work concept as applied to service, a multi-talented (handed) artist when applied to Arts, a block everything fighter, etc.

Another item we are interested in improving is Event Logistics. Our Baronial progress is listed on Campfire. We encourage everyone to mark what events they plan to attend so that we can better coordinate ride-sharing, crash space arrangements, and field space organization.



Pennsic approaches swiftly and so does the panic of preparation. Be sure to practice self-care. This is a marathon , not a sprint.

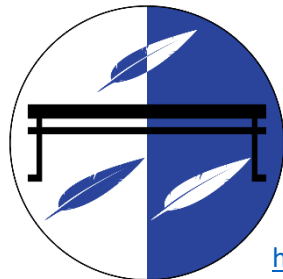

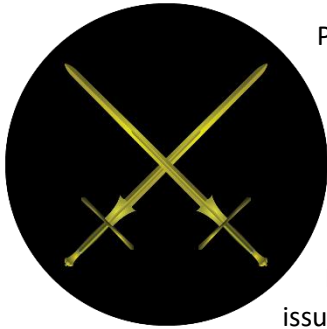
Want to serve the Fighter Community by providing Tournament organization and keeping the Fighting Authorizations documented? Consider becoming a Minister of the List.
