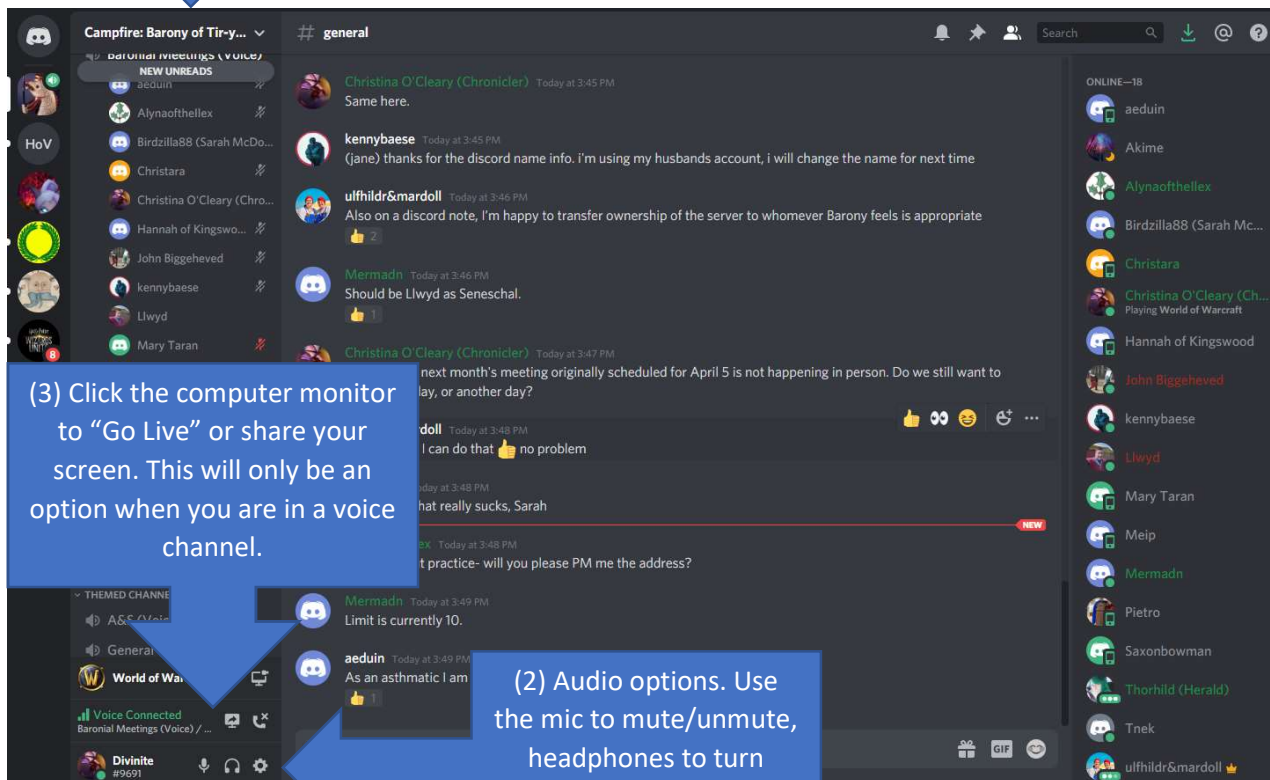

(1) Right click to access server options.

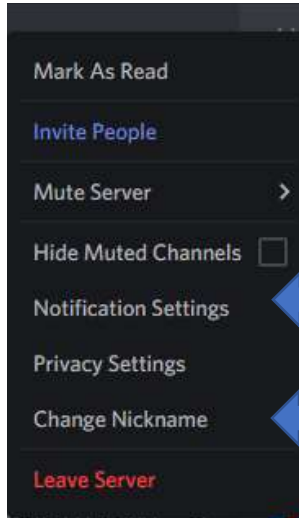


(3) Click the computer monitor to "Go Live" or share your screen. This will only be an option when you are in a voice channel.

## 1. Server options menu

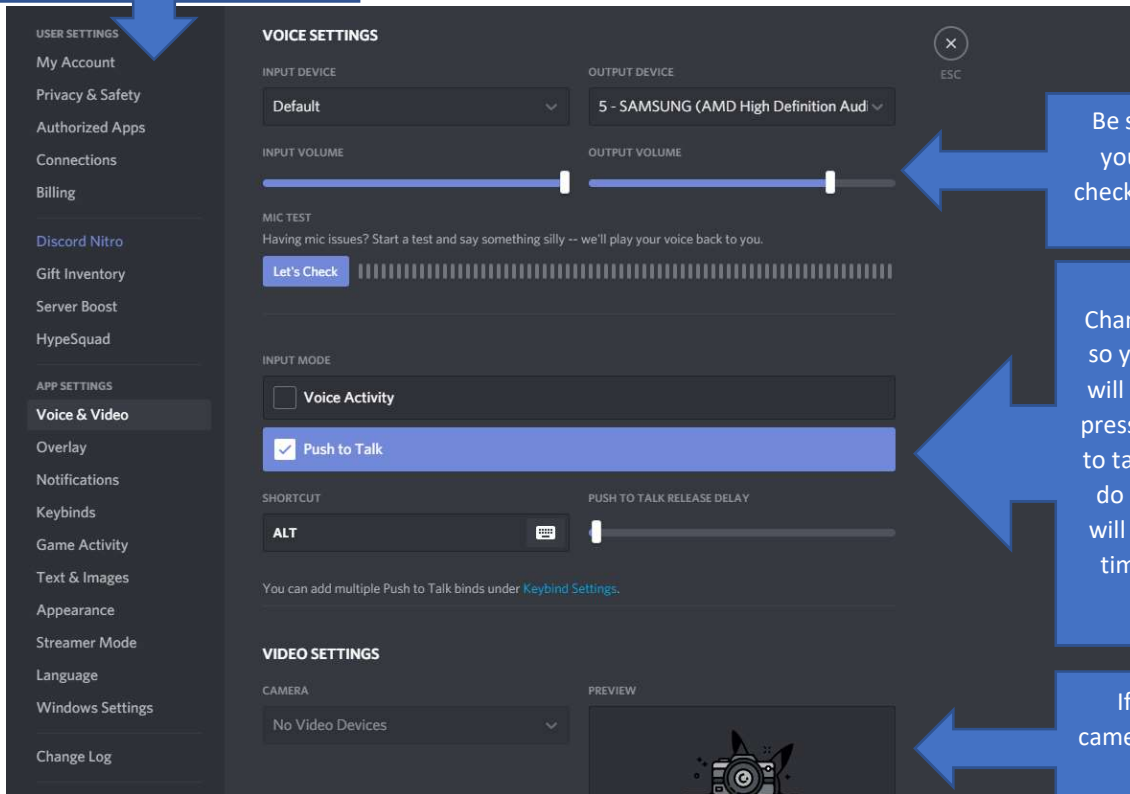

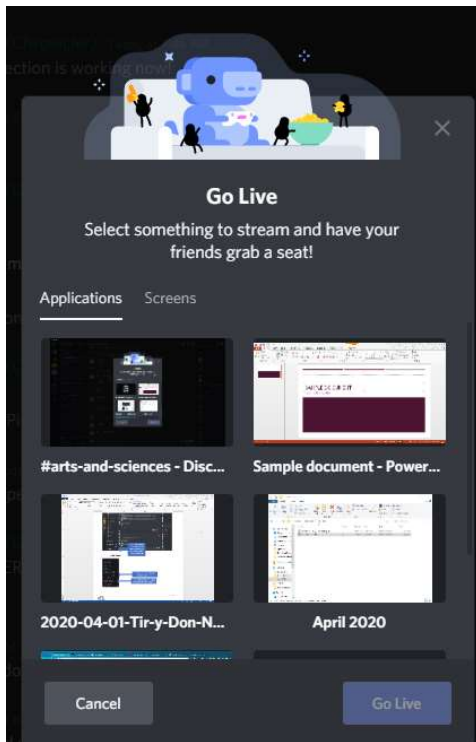
Be sure to setup your voice and check levels of your mic!

Change this option so your voice chat will require you to press a key in order to talk. If you don't do this, your mic will activate every time you speak.

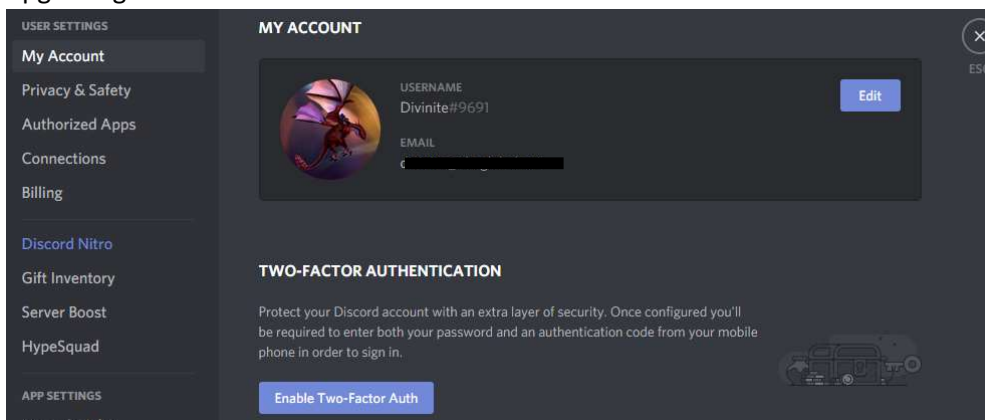
If you have a camera, you can set it up here.

## *Officer Reports*

---

### *Seneschal*

Society gave Kingdom permission to hold coronation virtually. K&Q will go to TRH house and hold court with a very small audience, give awards, and hand off the crown. No plan for Crown tournament at this time. We'll see how that plays out. We're all virtual for now, BB will be discussed after Officer Reports.

### *Exchequer*

We have money. Still has all pre-reg checks for BB, just in case we need to cancel. PayPal will be reported after meeting today. Quarterly report due April 30.

### *Chatelaine*

We have a few new folks chatting on Discord in the rapier channel. Having the additional resource has been helpful. South Hampton Ren Faire and Harvest Faire have been cancelled. We did to the demo at the Williamsburg library in February, but don't think it reached the audience we were hoping for, it's a beautiful facility. They are considering something in the fall, we'll see if we are invited back and if we're interested. Parking was a nightmare. We have had a few new faces at in person A&S meetings.

### *Chronicler*

Submission deadline is the 25<sup>th</sup>. Please send content. Since we're not meeting in person right now, getting information out through the newsletter is important. A&S class notes, any articles, photos. Discord information will be included.

### *Herald*

As of right now, not really anything for herald. If anyone wants to discuss anything, it can be done remotely. If you want to send something to Golden Dolphin, forms will need to be emailed,



mailed/mailed. Money will need to be sent directly to Golden Dolphin, baronial herald is not accepting money at this time. First quarter report is being worked on.

### *Knights Marshal*

Not a lot going on in regards to practices. If a few people are interested in getting together for archery (2-3 people), there should not be an issue, as long as it stays below 10 people and the range stays open. In order for us to do Equestrian practices, we need SCA insurance. We got insurance for April 5 and June 7. Likely that April 5 will be cancelled, we'll have to wait and see for June 5. You can get insurance for as many practices as you want to for the year, but you have to specify them to get them included in the \$50 charge. Tnek paid for insurance, seeking reimbursement. Falls under allowance. We will have to check to see if it's possible to change the date on the insurance certificate, given the circumstances.

### *Archery*

We are not sure if NNPark archery range is currently closed because you may not be able to sign in. Practices are TBD, watch Facebook. We will post if the park is open and if we will be holding practice.

### *Arts and Sciences*

Stumbling along. Following CDC recommend not to hold meetings at the house. We tested with the HMA class online. There were 8 accounts, 10 people online, a really good turnout for our first online. If anyone is interested in teaching online, speak up, we'll get really creative with meetings. We'll readdress our schedule once we can. There is a video option in Discord. We will have an Egyptian Museum Review and Dayboard class the next few weeks. We have options for G suite/Google Meet, WebEx.

We will need to address upcoming events on the barony page. A&S classes will be updated as they are scheduled. I have been having Netflix parties with a chat component if people want to do movie nights.

#### *Baronial Birthday*

We will only lose the \$85 for the ABC license. Muriel will check with the ABC board to see if they will refund due to circumstances or provide a credit to roll over to the next event. No opposition to cancelling/postponing at this time.

We will ask Kingdom about the possibility of the conflict rule being suspended.



Alyna will be refunding PayPal and sending checks back. We will update Facebook, and notify anyone who was planning on coming (TRH, MOL, etc.). Llwyd will update the website. Michael will notify the park at the archery event scheduled for April 5 is cancelled.

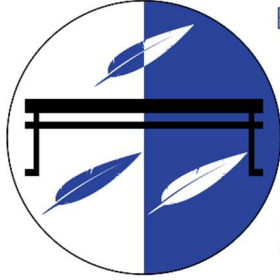

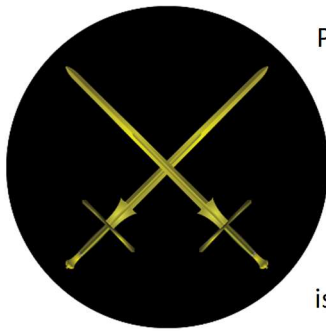
