

Baron and Baroness

Hope all are well. His Excellency is self-isolating as he has had a fever. A lot of new things have been sent out by the Seneschal's that Llwyd will cover later. Calontir Trim has contacted us to make Tir-Y-Don custom trim. He is in contact with us to finalize the design. He will join the Campfire group to discuss order minimums.

There are virtual courts upcoming. The only way to get an award is to opt in on the Kingdom website. You can opt-in at the Electronic Polling System using the same login information as University.

Officer Reports

Seneschal

The reopening policy has been linked on the Facebook page. We are at Phase 0. This is based on a running average of infection rate. When things improved we will move up to Phase 1. If it gets worse, we may move back to Closed. At Phase 1 we can do archery, A&S, equestrian, no marshal activities at this time. There are limitations, 10 people maximum, no children, attendance records will be kept for tracing. We can decide as a barony if we want to allow minimum activities to resume. It seems to be that we can resume archery. (Their Excellencies agree as long as social distancing is maintained). If the archers want to schedule practices, they can do so. If they don't want to deal with the increased requirements that will be up to them.

Arts and Sciences

A&S isn't working right, we need some new ideas. Start at normal 7 o'clock time, with a 7:05 start. Start each class with mute the mic, more aggressive at muting folks that aren't teaching. At Pennsic classes, they were clocking in about 30-60 minutes. Our normal classes are 60-90 minutes and this is wearing. We may end up on a different platform, but don't know which yet. We may switch to a template schedule, unless we have a lot of teachers come out of the woodwork. Templates would be Week 1: Lecture, Week 2: Research, Week 3: Unknown/Business Meeting/Joint with Caer Maer, Week 4: Field Trip. If we get enough people to do lectures, we can do more. We can do a cocktail hour or dessert host or take and make with your own items. We are going to try to work with Caer Maer as they are also having trouble scheduling things. We might be on multiple platforms depending on if we're doing a University test teach (on whatever platform the teacher is on). Let Kaleeb know preference on where to post links for classes. Will likely be posted on Campfire and Discord as these are both private and we do not want links posted publicly.

New List Field

We determined that the existing list fence was not salvageable. We started thinking about what we want as a list field and if we want to copy that design or come up with something else. Single metal stands with a loop were discussed. We decided we need to speak with some other baronies about what they like about their list fences. We need to duplicate twice the amount of list fence due to the new regulations on list size and distance between fighting and audience. We are open to any ideas you've seen. Their Excellencies are going to speak to the other baronage. If you have pictures of other list fences, please share them. Possible design criteria: more durable, covers more list area, needs to fit within the designated storage space.
