Notes from Unevent

From the Armored Marshals' Meeting

It is the responsibility of all marshals to read and know the changes instituted by the KEM. These changes are in line with, in support of, and clarify the Kingdom reopening guidelines pertinent to marshal activities. These rules and clarifications are for the stage when we are able to gather and have official activities in person. This is not an avocation of having such in-person activities at this time.

“Participant” means anyone participating in any capacity in an official in-person activity be they fighters, marshals, MoLs, by-standers, etc.

“Activity” means any goings-on such as fighter practice, event, demo, etc.

- Masks shall be worn at all times from the time participants arrive at the activity and get out of their vehicle until they get back into their vehicle to leave the activity.



- Exceptions are allowed for temporary removal of masks, away from other participants to drink water or to fix or replace a damaged, wet, or misaligned masks.
- Masks shall be worn during combat, under your helm.
- Masks will not be provided. Every participant must bring their own masks in sufficient quantity to remain properly masked for the duration of the activity.
- Marshal Activities will only be at outdoor venues until the level of restriction is lifted in Phase 5 (full reopening) of Reopening Atlantia.
- No sharing of food or beverages at the activity other than of family units/roommates.
- There will be no provision of food or beverages. Everyone must bring their own. No water/Gatorade will be provided.
- Marshals shall wear a new, unused pair of disposable gloves for each inspection.
- Allow extra time and space for inspections to allow for changes of gloves and social distancing of all participants.
- Fighters will have been out of practice for at least a year by the time in-person practice and events happen again. Fitness will be down, weight will be up, skills rusty, and masks will have to be worn during combat activities. Leather will be dry-rotted, helmets foam/padding will be degraded, and armor may not fit well anymore. So, take care of yourselves and your kits. Get used to fighting and strong physical exertion with masks on. Make sure your masks work while wearing your helm and stay in place. Have extra masks to change when your mask gets too soaked with sweat to breathe through.

From the MOAS meeting

Officer Reports

Seneschal

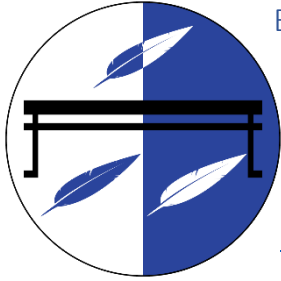

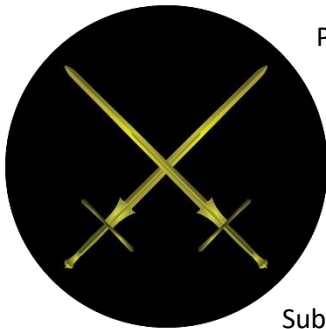
