

Baron and Baroness

Marinus has approached us regarding Rip Rap War 2022. They would like to hold it, but it's technically our year. They are looking at dates in November. No objections to them taking over this year.

We will not be having field space at Coronation. We will be assisting with feast, as eldest daughter is cooking. Coronation is in Elchenburg, NC.

Officer Reports

Seneschal

Will be at Defending the Gate. Hoping it will not be raining. Parking is on gravel. Hope to see many there. Kingdom Seneschal is stepping down, looking for applicants.

Exchequer

Official changes from Kingdom have not yet been written up. Will send for review to officers once complete. A new Google account has been created for the Exchequer. This was done as Kingdom has discontinued use of Drop Box. All of this will be sorted before next quarterly report is due next month. Signature card is at Corporate, waiting for confirmation to remove former officer. We still have money. Books have been reviewed, we are in good standing.

Corporate wants to know details about our trailer and recommends insurance for the person that will be towing as well as for the stuff that is inside of it. They are asking for an official contract between the tower and the barony. We have two trailers, one that stays at Pennsic and is only towed around the site. The other is local and brought to events.

Andrei has volunteered to get some quotes. Kaleeb has a photographic record of the Pennsic trailer. Both are single axel. 5x9 and 6x10. Both are enclosed.

Chatelaine

No newcomer's have contacted in the past month. Need to get email and contact information updated on the website. Will be Defending the Gate and assisting with the Newcomer's Tour. Looking for ways to expand our membership, CNU demos are a possibility. Will reach out to a history professor to see if there would be anything they want/need.



We have the Mosey on April 9. Kaleeb will have paperwork to hand off. Newport News Fall Festival has reached out to Kaleeb, asked for a single day as we do not have the population to run both days. Andrei will take over running the demo, with Kaleeb assisting. Will find out about heavy fighting, live steel is not allowed.

Andrei will look into different options for advertising. Will reach out to Kingdom Chatelaine and see if there are any good people to talk to. Roxbury Mills has done a pretty extensive recruiting campaign. There used to be a College at William & Mary but they have been dormant.

Old Business

List field

Nothing new has happened. We want to keep the discussion alive so we can be ready when we have an event that needs a list field.

Trailer Tires

Tires from TireRack.com are \$130 each for Goodyear. CostCo has a different brand for \$90 each. Goodyear are fairly well reviewed by those that tow RVs. Spare is a different size. In total would be \$411.69 at TireRack.com. If we can fill out the tax exempt form we can knock tax off.

A lot of shops do not do trailer tire installation. The one shop found would be \$89.97 to install. CostCo might be less, but they have strict requirements for which tires they will install. Grand total of \$501.66. If we want to



standardize the spare, we would need to buy a wheel as well, which would be another \$100-\$150. We might want to look into anti-flat mats which are about \$100 and would help with keeping the tires proper. BJ's does not carry trailer tires. We will revisit next month. Andrei will see if he can find the plaque on the trailer with the installation. If total is less than \$500 okay to go before next meeting.

New Business

Baronial Birthday

Assuming we can use the club we were going to use last time, would like to host Birthday on the third Saturday of June. Andrei will write up a proposal. There is interest, but Llwyd has some concern about staff. Oriana thinks we can get people from Marinus to help if needed.

Next meeting April 21. Meetings will remain virtual at this time.
