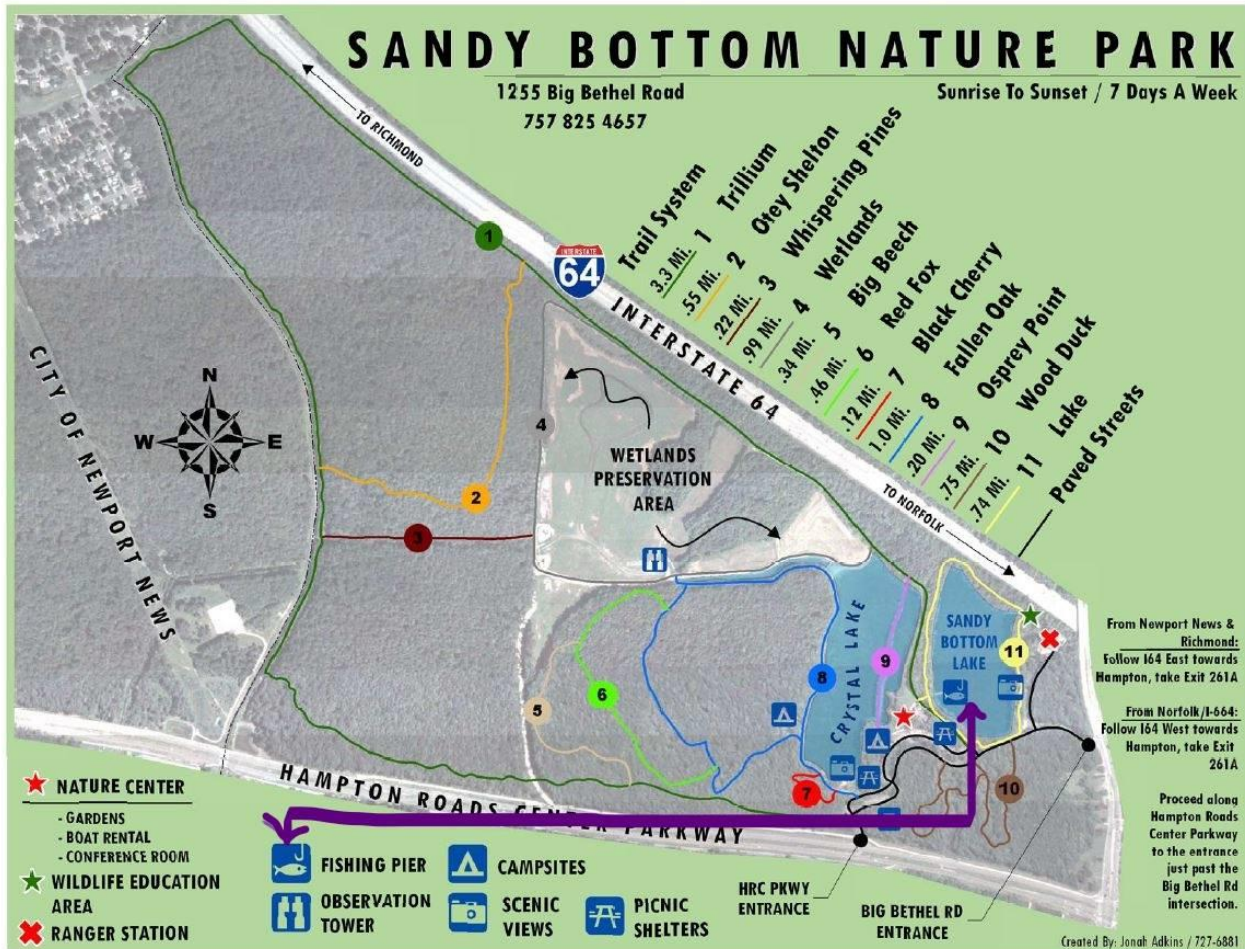

Old & New Business

Old Business

List field

Andrei has priced out the poles. Making 40 portable holes out of right angle steel, rings, dowels, rope. Total approximately \$532 for 240 linear feet of field, 60'x60' with poles every 6'. We should already have rope in the trailer. Will leave it in the budget until we verify it is there and still usable. We can likely cut the budget with wholesale costs. Amount for portable holes only approved for \$250. Will address dowels and rope after holes are made. John will measure the storage bin to verify the max length of the poles.

Trailer Tires

Went to get tires from the trailer. The trailer needs to be repaired. The sway bar is not connected to the frame and is rusted out. It is not safe to move. Sergio came and looked at it. He has the metal to reinforce it. He would need cutting wheels and welding rods. The axel is rusted and the hubs are held on by duct tape and leaking grease. Repair costs approximately \$450 for new axel assembly and frame repair. \$500 approved for buffer.

We will likely need to empty the trailer to do the repairs. We will also need to weigh the trailer and make sure it is within weight limits.

New trailer costs start at \$5,000 and go up. Tried to get quotes for insurance on the trailer, need make and model. Serial number of trailer is not there. Whoever has registration might have that information. Need info on the trailer at Pennsic.



Baronial Birthday

Plan is to have it at Marlbank Farm, on Old Landing Road, where we were going to have the last Birthday before it was cancelled due to COVID. Proposed date 6/18/22. We would be sharing the parking lot with pool users. There would be a discount on the site fee with a member sponsoring. Llwyd will check to see if his parents will qualify for the discount.

We will get a banquet license from ABC. Need Marshals' & MOL. Champions will be made. Archery will be held the weekend after, June 26. Alyna will discuss with the archery Marshals to arrange that.

Budget passed and approved to Spike.

There is enough interest to have a baronial camp. We will also have a day shade available. Estimated about 20+ people in camp. We can use the kitchen tent which is 15'x20' as the communal shade. More discussion to come about camp, meals, etc.

Traveling Fighter Practice

Llwyd was the only one that went up to Richmond last week. Have been in talks with Marinus about going to their practice. It's right over the MMBT, so it's not far over the bridge. Their practice is mostly heavy fighters, so we would be bringing the fencers. We will be looking at going on May 15.

There is a demo in Marinus this Saturday and a war practice at the park next to the demo. Andrei will be attending.

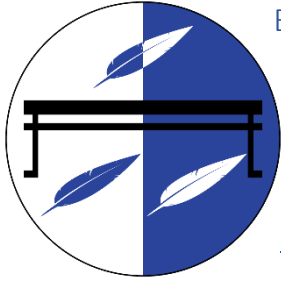

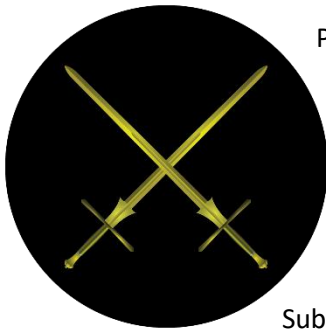
