Exchequer

New Business

Pennsic

Camp has been registered by Holly. We need someone who will be there Day 1 to be camp rep. Last year we did not have someone there Day 1 and we got in trouble, so we need to make sure it doesn't happen again. Holly will check to see if there are any official proxies and will see about signing for the camp. Their Excellencies will be there first Saturday. This year will be Pennsic 50 and will have pretty high numbers. Register early just in case they cap out.

Kingdom A&S Bid



There are two bids in, both in the Northern part of the Kingdom. If we want to submit, we would like to use Bethel HS or one of the other HS in Hampton. The schools are very cheap, at max \$1150 for the day. If we can get the 501c3 documents approved by the schools, then the cost goes to about \$200. Unfortunately this means we would not be able to host Kingdom Brewer. Voted 7-6 in favor of submitting the bid. No votes preferred to submit for next year for the Helenistic Center.
